A chance to see 5 different Eco-systems in Southern Africa, the habitat for Africa's countless animals. In each area you will find a variety of animal life and vegetation and meet gracious and friendly residents. At all your stops you will be surprised at how close you can get to view the African animals. You will return with extraordinary photographs of your encounters. Guides are extremely informative. Flying the African sky is a pleasure with great views, good landing strips, and friendly controllers.

In this itinerary you'll have 4 nights stay in Johannesburg for briefings, safari preparations and pilot validation exercises. **You should arrive by May 31, 2026 afternoon or evening Hotel check in is at 2pm so plan your flights accordingly. If arriving in the early morning, rather plan your arrival for the morning of June 1.**

Pricing is based on 2 people sharing a Cessna 172/182 aircraft or similar and sharing accommodation in the same room. Double or Twin single beds are as per your preference. If you are both pilots and each require a validation, add on an additional \$1000 for the validation for the second pilot. If 2 persons sharing an aircraft each require their own rooming, single supplements apply.

The price includes:

All accommodation and meals, except where only Bed and Breakfast is noted. Drinks as noted.
Lodge standard activities and any extra activities as noted.
All road transfers to and from airports/airstrips.
National Park entrance fees, where applicable.
Rental of a Cessna 172 / Cessna 182 or similar for 24 hours on a dry basis (min 2 hours/day).
All aircraft landing, passenger, and approach fees while in Johannesburg.
Excess insurance (hull deductible).
Licence validation fees, Instructor briefings and dual flight time for your validation for 1 Pilot.
A subscription to EasyCockpit flight planning software and with preprogrammed flight legs.
Detailed Flight Itinerary, and Comprehensive TripKit in Pdf and printed form (your bible for your safari).
All flight clearances
Pre-completed Customs and Immigration documentation where possible.
Pre-completed flight plans for your flights (pre-filed where possible).
Flight following using a Satellite Tracker
Ground support for the entire duration of the Safari from our offices in Johannesburg
All Safari briefings
An escort aircraft from African Aero Adventures to assist with flight briefing and formalities en-route.

Not included:

Airfare to South Africa and return

Personal Medical and Travel insurance

Visa and entry/exit fees.

Avgas, oil and aircraft charges and fees en-route (outside Johannesburg).

Items of a personal nature, curios, tips, laundry, and specialty drinks unless otherwise noted.

Conservation or tourist levy fees charged at some of the lodges (about \$3 - \$10 per person).

Transportation in and around Johannesburg. We suggest using Uber while you are in Johannesburg.

Your Itinerary

May 31, (Sunday).

Arrive in the AM at Johannesburg International Airport where you will be transferred to the **Pivot Hotel next door to the Monte Casino Centre**, Fourways, on the outskirts of Johannesburg for 4 nights while completing your pilot validations. We will meet you after your arrival and will commence briefing as soon as you have settled in. We are flexible, however have a lot of work to cover, therefore the sooner we get started, the better. Non pilots can go to all the briefings if they wish.

Check in is at 14H00 only, so if you are arriving early in the morning, and wish to go directly to a room advise us and we will book an extra night for you.

Throughout your time in Johannesburg, optional tours for non-pilots can be arranged with the Hotel concierge Desk to do various activities such as visit the Lesedi Cultural Village, Origins Center, Sterkfontein Caves, Cradle of Humankind, Lion Park, and Botanical Garden.

June 01, (Monday).

Instructor's briefing and Validation Tasks. You'll get a chance to focus on some of the differences of flying in Africa. Professionals do all the briefings. You'll get the lay of the land and a taste of how ATC works (and sounds) in Africa's busiest airspace. Possible Validation Check Flight today

June 02 & 03, (Tuesday & Wednesday).

Completion of Validation exercises if not done, time on your own and a final afternoon briefing. Arrange to settle your hotel bill that evening and for an early breakfast.

June 04, Thursday – Fly the African Bush –

Transfer to the departure airport where we'll meet you to assist in our Self-Fly Safari departure. Sign out the aircraft, load it, check the fuel, top off the tanks, and take care of all the last-minute details. We can store any excess luggage at our offices as required. Soft duffle type bags are recommended for your safari. Soon, we are on our way!

June 04 & 05 (Thursday & Friday) - MALAMALA MAIN CAMP or similar, Sabi Sands, Greater Kruger National Park, South Africa

(Northeast 207nm- direct flight) - Private airstrip, 2 nights, all meals and local drinks, game drives, airstrip transfers.

Your first destination is MalaMala, located in the prime game area of Sabi Sands, South Africa. You'll fly over the Drakensburg Mountains and descend the Escarpment into the famous Kruger National Park area of rolling woodland bush and grassland savanna. The variety of game is extraordinary. They're all here: leopard, cheetah, lion, rhino, hippo, elephant, wildebeest, buffalo, giraffe, zebra, warthog, spotted hyena, impala, and more. MalaMala, located along the Sand River, is in South Africa's prime game viewing area. Rooms are large, thatched chalets. The food is delicious and the service outstanding. The guides who will drive you throughout their traversing area are well informed and you will have extraordinary animal viewing experiences. Game drives take place in the early morning and late afternoon into the evening. During the middle of the day, you can relax in your room, at the pool or rest in their lounge area.

June 06 & 07 (Saturday & Sunday) — MASHATU LODGE, Mashatu Game Reserve, Botswana

*(231nm Northwest then North with 1 fuel and immigration stop) - Limpopo Valley airstrip, 2 nights, all meals, game drives, **special** airstrip transfers. (Laundry charges are extra)*

Mashatu is situated on the eastern fringes of the Kalahari Desert and water is its most precious resource. Mashatu camp is near water in thickets of vegetation, which locates the visitor in an enclave populated by birds and animals. Mashatu Lodge is an oasis among the undulating and seemingly endless plains of the wild. 14 luxury suites lie along the camp's perimeter and are designed to allow

absolute privacy and communion with the bush and its inhabitants. Watch elephants splashing at the waterhole, listen to the lyrical melody of the Woodland's Kingfisher on a branch overhead, smell the grassy scent of the bushveld, touch the bark of an ancient tree, and inhale a breath of air so pure, it's intoxicating. Meals are a sumptuous celebration of traditional African Cuisine – flavorful but lacking in ostentation. Fresh fruits, vegetables, home-made breads and pies, succulent meat dishes and delicious desserts will appeal to a guest who appreciates home cooking at its best.

June 08 & 09 (Monday & Tuesday) – KANANA Camp (or similar), Okavango Delta, Botswana

(383nm Northwest with 1 fuel stop) - Private airstrip, 3 nights, all meals and local drinks, laundry, activities, airstrip transfers.

A hidden jewel on the Xudum River, Kanana is located in the southwest of the Okavango Delta. The area encompasses a necklace of islands dotted with palms, figs, ebony and knobthorn, and is home to a myriad of birds, plants and animals. The nature of the habitat means it is the perfect place to experience the diversity of species found within the Okavango Delta. Guests are accommodated in seven spacious twin and double-bedded safari tents, each en-suite bathroom has a large walk-in shower and luxurious fittings. Families are accommodated in a two-bedroomed tent, sharing an en-suite bathroom with the addition of an outdoor shower. The tents are well spaced, affording privacy whilst remaining within a comfortable distance from the main camp area. Activities include guided walks, Mokoro excursions and night drives in addition to game drives and motor boating. Wildlife is in abundance with frequent predator sightings such as lion, leopard and wilddog all making Kanana their hunting grounds. Due to the camp's location guests can experience magnificent game sightings during drives as well as the unique experience of exploring the delta's beautiful waterways by boat or Mokoro at times that the annual Okavango Delta flooding allows these activities to happen.

June 10 & 11 (Wednesday & Thursday) - VICTORIA FALLS HOTEL, Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

(200nm Northeast and East Southeast with 1 fuel and immigration stop) - Victoria Falls Airport, 2 nights, Bed & Breakfast, airport transfers.

Today you fly to Victoria Falls to visit and overfly the famous Victoria Falls. You will be staying at the historic, grand Victoria Falls Hotel. The Hotel, popularly known as “the grand old lady of the Falls”, is situated in the Victoria Falls National Park, a world heritage site. The Edwardian-style hotel, built in 1904, was recently refurbished and is set in lush tropical gardens with lily ponds, palm trees and semi-tropical shrubs. The Falls are just a ten-minute walk away. Its opulent Livingstone Room is known for fine dining and dancing. The Stanley Terrace, with its clear view of the Victoria Falls Bridge connecting Zimbabwe and Zambia, is renowned for its cocktails and afternoon teas. All rooms are decorated in the gracious Edwardian style of Zimbabwe’s colonial era.

June 12 & 13 (Friday & Saturday) - LITTLE MAKALOLO, Hwange National Park, Zimbabwe

(102nm East – direct flight) - Private airstrip, 2 nights, all meals and local drinks, laundry, game drives, airstrip transfers.

Your final safari destination is within Zimbabwe’s massive Hwange National Park. You will land in the south-eastern section of the Hwange Park in the Linkwasha Vlei. It’s a fantasy of airborne Africa: flying low over golden, flat, savanna grasslands, easing down until your wheels touch, and rolling to a gentle stop. This is an area of large herds of elephant and buffalo, spotted hyena, giraffe, sable antelope, lion, and leopard. You will have day and night game drives, a guided walk in the morning (if you wish) and the luxury of game viewing from your tent’s veranda as animals come to drink from a well-situated water hole. Accommodation is in large walk-in tents with ensuite bathrooms.

1 Night Bed & Breakfast & airport transfer.*

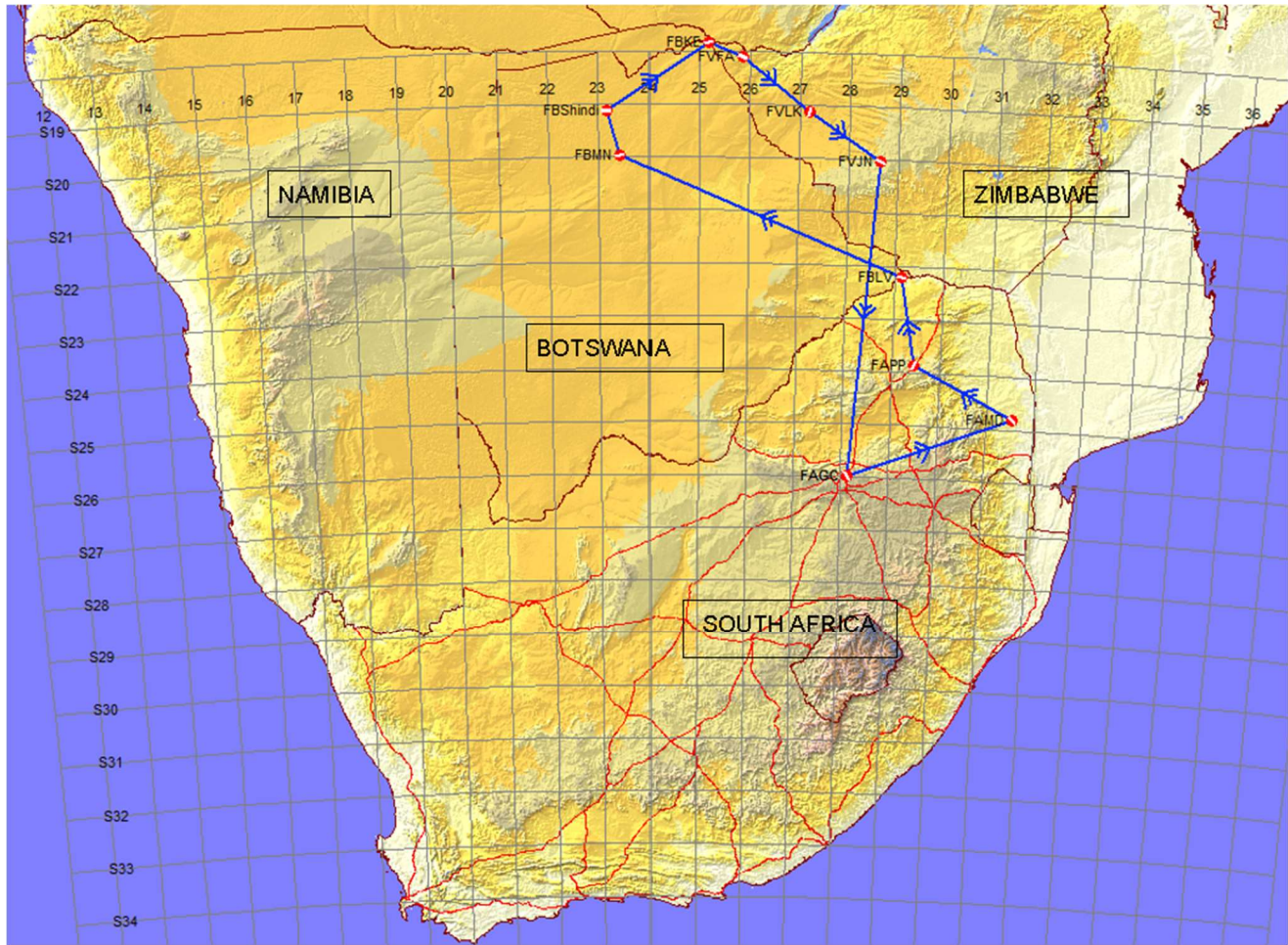
